

Request for Qualifications (RFQ) FOOD AND BEVERAGE CONCESSIONAIRE MidAmerica St. Louis Airport, County of St. Clair, Illinois Solicitation No. 2022-08

Owner: St. Clair County Public Building Commission on behalf of St. Clair County, Illinois, as owner, operator and sponsor of MidAmerica St. Louis Airport (the Commission and St. Clair County collectively hereinafter referred to as the "Owner") hereby gives notice that Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) will be received from qualified concessionaires to provide food, beverage, ATM, and vending services for the Airport.

ACDBE Participation: St. Clair County promotes equal opportunities and encourages participation by Airport Concessions Disadvantage Business Enterprise (ACDBE) firms. A goal of 9.45% ACDBE participation has been established for this project.

Submittal Rejection: This RFQ does not obligate the Owner to execute an Agreement with any consultant nor to pay any cost incurred in the preparation of any SOQ submitted in response to this RFQ. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all submittals, waive any informalities in submittals, or to accept a submittal which best serves the interests of the Owner.

Time and Place of SOQ Submittal: SOQs will be received until 2:00 p.m. (local time) on April 29, 2022 in the Airport Department of Engineering & Planning. The SOQ must be submitted in accordance with all submission requirements set forth in the RFQ. Facsimile submittals are not acceptable. Late proposals will not be accepted. Questions must be directed in writing as detailed in the RFQ.

RFQ Documents: The RFQ is available effective 8:00 A.M. on April 1, 2022. Concessionaires interested in submitting an SOQ may request the RFQ from the Airport Department of Engineering & Planning by email (alice.tejada@flymidamerica.com). The RFQ and subsequent addenda (should there be any) will be distributed exclusively via e-mail.

Pre-Submittal Conference: A <u>virtual</u> pre-submittal conference is scheduled for 10:00 am on April 14, 2022. A link to the conference will be provided to the concessionaire once the RFQ has been requested.
