1. Parking Service Agreement / REEF Parking

The purpose of the Fourth Amendment is to extend the parking service agreement for twelve months. During this period, the airport will evaluate selection and implementation of additional parking management technology, which will improve the customer experience and provide for greater revenue control and accountability.

<u>Financial Impact</u>: All parking revenue will be used to operate and maintain the airport. The financial obligations contained within the service agreement were included in the FY2023 Airport Budget.

Motion: "Move to approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the Fourth Amendment of the service agreement between MidAmerica St. Louis Airport and REEF Parking."



2. Consulting Services / Non-AIP Construction Phased Services / CMT

This non-AIP eligible work includes administrative offices, tenant offices, access control system changes necessitated by the changes in the terminal, changes to the existing telecommunications room in the terminal, and the associated work necessary to accomplish these changes. Since the work associated with the original scope and amendment #1 is under construction, there is a need for the consultant to provide construction phase services for this work.

<u>Financial Impact</u>: The Non-AIP Consulting Services Amendment #2 was included in the FY2023 Airport Budget.

Motion: "Move to approve and authorize the Chairman to execute Amendment #2 of the Professional Services Agreement with CMT at a cost Not to Exceed \$39,390."



3. Equipment Procurement / Ford Interceptor / Public Safety

The existing Public Safety vehicle is a 2005 Ford Explorer acquired from the GSA Surplus Property list. The airport overhauled this vehicle so it could be put in service in 2011. Parts for unit have become obsolete, the vehicle is exhibiting rust and has extensive interior damage. It is no longer cost effective to repair. The new vehicle is to be purchased from Morrow Brothers Ford, Inc. (Greenfield, IL) utilizing the Illinois Bid Buy Program

<u>Financial Impact</u>: The procurement of the Public Safety vehicle was included in the FY2023 Airport Budget.

Motion: "Move to approve utilization of a state bid list to procure a Ford Interceptor from Morrow Brothers Ford, Inc. for a cost Not-to-Exceed \$52,000 and authorize the Airport Director to execute the agreement."

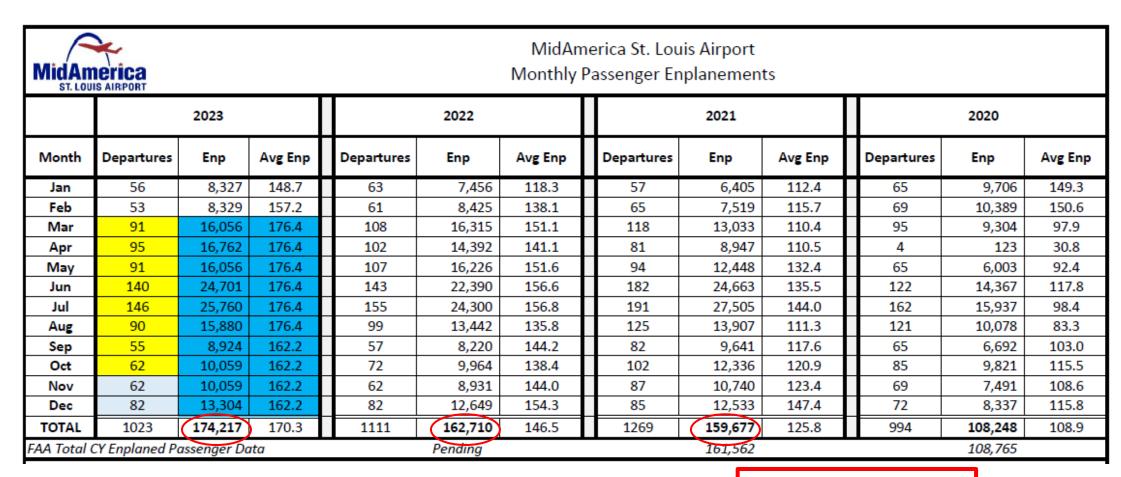

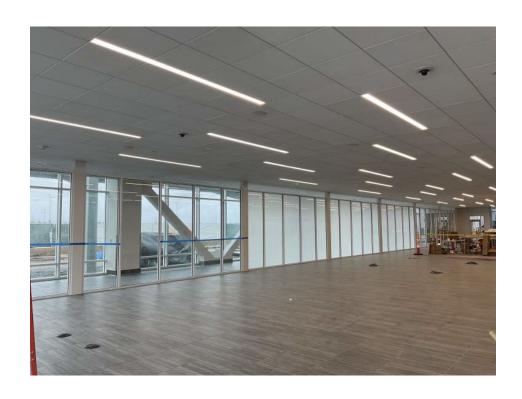

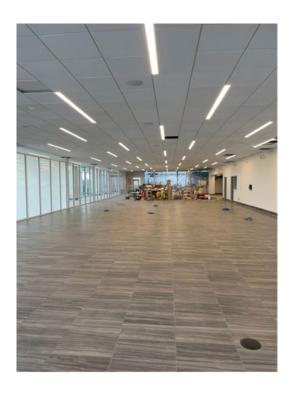
