Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS)

MidAmerica St. Louis Airport is participating in the Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) program, previously known as Earmarks for fiscal year 2023 and 2024. The federal appropriations process will permit Congress to directly fund local projects in the form of discretionary grants.

BLV FY2023 CDS Project - \$3.25million for the Federal Inspection Station (US Customs) – Congressman Bost

BLV FY2024 CDS Project - \$2.5million for the Terminal Apron Expansion — Senator Durbin and Congressman Bost



1. Consulting Services / Daley Policy Group

The MidAmerica St Louis Airport relies on certain federal funds to develop, maintain, and expand the airport's core infrastructure, which supports the operation of air carrier, air cargo, military, and general aviation aircraft operations. The Daley Policy Group is integral for the securing of federal grants and representation of the Airport's interest before Congress, Federal Agencies, and other officials with the Administration.

<u>Financial Impact</u>: The professional services agreement with the Daley Policy Group was included in the FY2023 Airport Budget.

Motion: "Move to approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the letter of engagement between MidAmerica St. Louis Airport and Daley Policy Group (DPG) for 1-year at a cost Not to Exceed \$72,000."

2. Consulting Services / Amendment #1 / EV Charging Station / WSP

MidAmerica St. Louis Airport is submitting for the FY23 Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (CFI) grant program. The Project will fund much needed Electric Vehicle Charging Stations at the Airport. WSP is needed to assist with the research, development and execution of the grant application and project implementation.

<u>Financial Impact</u>: The Consulting Services Amendment #1 with WSP was included in the FY2023 Airport Budget.

Motion: "Move to approve and authorize the Chairman to execute Amendment #1 of the Professional Services Agreement with WSP for a cost Not to Exceed \$28,364."

3. Equipment Procurement / Aircraft Push Back

MidAmerica St. Louis Airport owns, maintains, and operates multiple pieces of Ground Support Equipment (GSE). GSE is the equipment used at airports to service aircraft on the ground. A pushback is used to push aircraft back from the gate and/or reposition them on the apron. The airport currently owns four pushbacks. All date from the 1980's and 1990's with the most current model year 1995 pushback. A fifth pushback will allow coverage for each of the five gates and provide some redundancy for the aging pushback fleet.

<u>Financial Impact</u>: The procurement of an aircraft pushback was included in the FY2023 Airport Budget.

Motion: "Move to approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the purchase agreement with Aero Specialties, Inc. for a cost Not-to-Exceed \$189,000."
